When the war first broke out in Ukraine, our hearts were immediately drawn to help. At the same time, we felt a deep responsibility not to step away from our ongoing work in Moldova. Balancing both was a significant decision — one that weighed heavily on us — but the need was too great to ignore.

Thanks to the incredible generosity of our supporters, especially the Calleva Foundation, we were able to respond swiftly. Very quickly we established and equipped several new facilities within Ukraine to support the growing number of refugees — families who have lost everything and are still trying to survive amidst the devastation.

These centres are now operating well, and the demand for help continues to rise as the conflict escalates. Our financial support is more vital than ever as Russia pushes further into Ukraine. The situation has become even more urgent in recent years.

Through a combination of humanitarian aid deliveries and the new facilities, we've been able to reach thousands of people some needing help for only a short while, others who remain with us longer as they search for stability.

For many, the journey is still unfolding. They move forward with courage, still looking for a place to call home and because of our wonderful supporters, they don't have to walk that path alone.
